

***For Now*TM Art Tattoo Colours and Stencils FAQs**

*For Now*TM Art Tattoo products are very different to anything else on the market and we are asked lots of questions about them. Here are the most frequently asked questions and the answers to them, which we hope will be a help to you and your staff in advising your customers about *For Now*TM products.

Q How long do *For Now*TM Art Tattoos last?

A On average, three to five days. They last longer on dry skin than on oily skin and they won't last as long if they get rubbed by your clothing.

Q Can I re-use the stencils?

A Yes, usually about four or five times or until they lose their adhesive. Simply replace the used stencil on its backing sheet and carefully clean off the colour with a baby wipe or damp cloth. You can apply different colours when you re-use a stencil if you clean it after each use.

Q How long do I have to wait for the colours to dry?

A *For Now*TM colours will be touch-dry on your skin in two or three minutes.

Q How do I remove a *For Now*TM Art Tattoo when I want to?

A By rubbing it with a wet cloth or a baby wipe. Hot water and soap make removal even easier.

Q Does that mean that the tattoo will come off in the shower or the pool?

A Not if you take a little care. *For Now*TM Art Tattoos are very water resistant, so they stay on as long as you don't rub the tattoo when it is wet. You can also swim - in pools or the sea - without the tattoo coming off. Pat gently with a towel to dry - don't rub.

Q Are *For Now*TM colours safe for use on sensitive skin?

A Yes. All the colours are water-based and safe for cosmetic use. In the very unlikely event of irritation, the colour should be washed off immediately with soap and water.

Q I have heard about problems with some temporary tattoos, especially with children - are *For Now*TM Art Tattoos safe for use on children's skin?

A Yes. The serious problems regularly reported by TV and national newspapers, are caused by the chemical PPD, which is sometimes added to henna to make tattoos black instead of reddish-brown. Products containing PPD should never be applied to the skin. Avoid 'black henna' tattoos.
There is no PPD in *For Now*TM products.

Q Do I need to prepare my skin before applying *For Now*TM colours?

A No, but your skin should be clean, dry and free from oils or moisturiser for longest lasting tattoos. For best results, keep the tattoo dry for an hour or two after application.

Q How many temporary tattoos can I apply using the different types of colours?

A It depends on the design of course, but you can expect to apply around 20 tattoos with a Sparkle Colour and about 120 with the Standard and Pearlescent Tattoo Daubers.

Q What is the difference between the Sparkle Colour and the Standard or Pearlescent Daubers?

A The Sparkle pen has all its colour in the sponge tip ready to use, and the colour contains very fine cosmetic glitter so that the tattoo sparkles. You must replace the air-tight cap properly after every application or the colour will dry out, just as a felt tip pen would do.

The Standard and Pearlescent daubers have their colour in a tube, which you squeeze on to the sponge tip as needed. The colour in the tube will not dry out so you can use every drop.

The Standard colours are matt and the Pearlescent colours shimmer. You can mix and match the three different types of colours to create fabulous multi-colour tattoos.
